Abstracts related to any and all water research and management topics will be considered. Abstract must not exceed 250 words or a single page and must be submitted online via the New Mexico Water Resources Research Institute's homepage at <http://wri.nmsu.edu>. All accepted abstracts will be made available to participants.

Presenters whose papers are accepted for oral presentations will be limited to a 20-minute talk. **All speakers and poster presenters must register for the 2004 Symposium by July 30, 2004.** The registration fee for everyone, including speakers, poster presenters, and other attendees is \$20.
